CONSULT & BRIEFING

REQUIREMENT GATHERING

The second time FAQ meet with you is the requirement gathering stage. Project managers, Developing & Design personnel will acquire all the technical and visual requirements to prepare for the crucial stage of Development Analysis (scoping).

DEVELOPMENT ANALYSIS

The Development team will carefully breakdown and engineer a blueprint for the project. This is to evaluate the best possible work-plan, foresee issues and solutions. Initial estimates on cost/budget projections & time. May or may not include wire frames, (visual layout of work process/flow and function).

CUSTOMER REVISIONS

FAQ will meet with you again and present the written document (with or without wire frames). This is an opportunity to refine the processes in its design and function. Nail it down!

SCOPING DELIVERY

FAQ will present with you a final itemised blueprint (scope doc) and wire frames. Final projections of cost/budget & time. A working prototype may also be made available, (simulated working model). Then the decision on how you would like to continue is with the customer.
